Frost & Ice

We are expecting some colder weather and during this time we will be observing changes in frost and ice in the garden with the children.

How you could support your child's learning at home:

- Encourage your child to touch the frost and ice and talk about how it looks and feels.
- Freeze water to make ice cubes and Iollies.
- Use non-fiction books/ipads to explore countries with cold climates.

Birds

The children will be looking at birds in the garden, exploring bird related activities and finding out about birds in their natural habitat.

Night Owls will visit the nursery in February for an owl demonstration. It is an opportunity for the children to discuss and find about owls. They will have the opportunity to have a photo taken with an owl, these will then be available for parents to purchase later in February.

At Batford we welcome the chick eggs in February which are hugely popular. The children find it incredible to see the chicks hatch from the eggs and will be able to hold them. Naming the chicks inspires imaginative discussions..watch this space for what they come up with!

How you could support your child's learning at home:

- Visit <u>www.rspb.org.uk</u> for ideas and activities to do with your child.
- Do a bird watch in your garden/local park.
- Read/look at non-fiction books about birds.
- Put out food and don't forget water for the birds.

"People Who Help Us"

During this term the children will be learning about "People who help us". The types of people that we hope to have talking to children about are the Police, Firefighters, Doctors, Nurses, Paramedics, Teachers, Dentists, Vets, Waste Disposal workers, builders, etc

How you could support your child's learning at home:

- Talk to your children about different occupations.
- Read stories about "People who help us".
- Say "thank you" to the people that help us.

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Chinese Luna New Year

It is the year of the "Rabbit". We will explore cultural celebrations including making lanterns, Chinese writing, stories and songs.

How you could support your child's learning at home:

- Fact finding about China.
- Find China on a globe or map.
- Look at some Chinese writing.
- Eat some Chinese food

Recycling - on-going learning

The children will learn how and why we recycle. We do this by looking at books such as "George saves the world by lunchtime", looking at websites and taking part in recycling activities using junk modelling and sorting containers into paper/plastic/wood/metal.

How you could support your child's learning at home:

- Encourage children to recycle at home.
- Talk to them about different types of recycling.
- Recycle items by creative play, build a famous landmark out of recycled goods.



Spring/Changes/Growing/Easter

We will be exploring changes in the garden. Looking at signs of plants growing, leaves, blossom, changes in the weather. Children will be planting bulbs or seeds. Our theme concludes by the children taking part in an Easter bonnet parade and Easter egg hunt.

How you could support your child's learning at home:

- Visit a garden centre.
- Do some planting at home.
- Keep a weather diary.
- Make an Easter bonnet (more details to follow).
